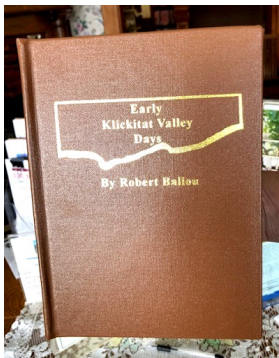

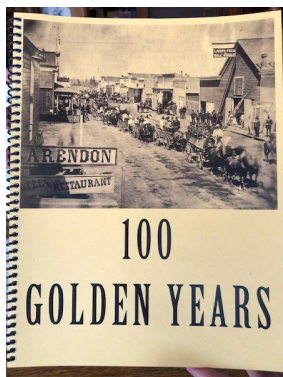
100 Golden Years

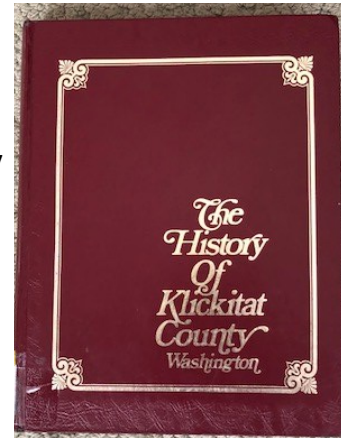
The History of Klickitat County

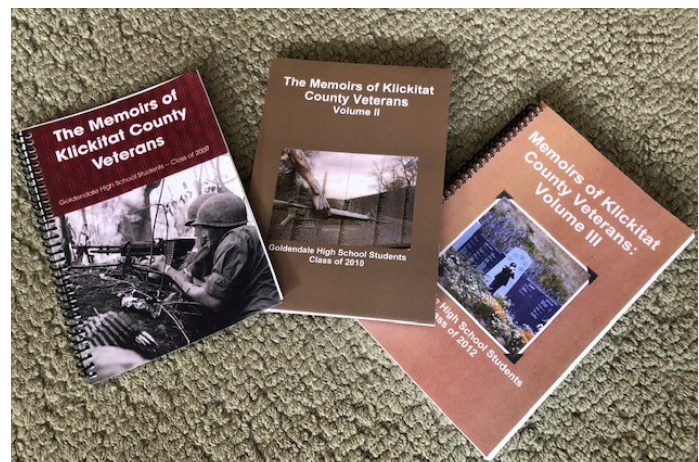


The Memoirs of Klickitat County Veterans
